STEVE'S BIG MOE rated just off leaders to the turn, rallied wide into the stretch, hooked in a long drive to be along in time late. RED RIVER TOCCTET tracked early, dueled into the deep stretch area, could not last while drifting out in the final furlong. PRINCINI saved ground throughout, moved up through the stretch and went evenly late. BEAMISH dueled for a half but started to fade into the stretch run. OUTRIDERS POSSE always trailed.
