CROWNFORADAY saved ground throughout, gained command into the stretch and was all out to last. CIELO LATER RED unhurried early, angled in past the quarter pole and finished well in the final stages to just miss. AT THE STATION vied on the lead outside, overtaken through the stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. LINEMAN was off slow, rallied to the turn, circled field past the quarter pole and moved up late. DIGGIN FASTER was through early. PEE WEE'S EDGE vied on the lead from inside to the stretch but gave way in the drive. ITTY BITTY STAMP was through early.
