NO EXPOSURE stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. COLERAINE was in a good stalking position while saving ground, had no rally. SKIPPY O was unhurried early, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. HOLIDAY BLAZE failed to menace. LIGHT MY DAY was no factor. RUSHLAND was no threat.
