DEVIL'S LIL BIT pressed the pace from the inside early, rallied on the turn and drew clear in upper stretch, was under firm handling to the finish. GALLOWAY dueled for the lead from the outside and prompted the pace, could not go with the winner in the stretch but was second best. DEVILS RAILWAY CAT was well placed in mid pack, improved position in the stretch but was no threat to the top two. DAME YANKEE was in a good stalking position on the outside, ran evenly and had no rally. FRENCH NATIVE was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. OHIO LILY stalked the pace evenly from the inside, had no rally. COCOABUCKS failed to menace. HALLISTER was no threat. LOLLICAT showed good early speed dueling for the lead, gave way and dropped back.
