FANCY TRAIN dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, rallied and drew clear in upper stretch, was under constant urging to the wire. LAST RIDE COWBOY was unhurried early, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. GET READY HATERS stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. ZAPATON was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. LONG SHOT LUKE dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. MR. MARCH bore in at the start and bothered foe, showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. BLUMESDAY was pinched back at the start, was no threat.
