CAT MAN was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, wore down rivals and was all out to get up in the final strides. ALABAMA GOLD dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, drew clear in upper stretch, led late but was outfinished to the wire. QUIET EMARATI was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. PANDA was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. CRAFTY CAPE showed good early speed, faltered and faded. SILVER TALK RIB set the pace with good speed while saving ground, gave way and dropped back.
