COMMONWEALTH RUSH dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, was all out to hold sway late. MOON ON OVER stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. MOONLIGHT GRAHAM was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. BEAR KIRIDASHI KID showed good early speed while four wide, ran evenly with no rally. DURAZNO showed good early speed while five wide, faltered and faded. BROWN FEATHER was no factor, passed tiring rivals. ANOTHER BULL RUN was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. MALIBU MYSTERY flashed brief speed before stopping. HOT PURSUIT had no rally or excuse.
