CARSON KID unhurried for a half while saving ground, rallied with a wide open run through the stretch to get up late. CAT ON set the pace to deep stretch, bore out badly through the stretch while outfinished in the late going. SEASCAPE never far back, floated widest with left handed urging coming out of the turn with no gain in the stretch. RED ILLUSION raced evenly while never a factor. MAGICAL DISGUISE raced inside into the first turn, made a bid at the half but dropped back thereafter. SANDRINGHAM SANDA was through after a half. DOC'S SLIPPERS had a staggered start while never a factor.
