DE VARONA stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the far turn and took the lead, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to hold sway late. CHIPAWILD was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, flattened out and ran evenly late. STARWATERS was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade late. ARGO NAVIS was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. APTITUDE'SATTITUDE stumbled at the start and nearly fell down, was no factor but did improve position. UNLADYLIKE was no factor. TRAIL OF SILVER set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. RUSHING GIRL showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
