O'RIAIN stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch, was all out to hold sway late. POLITE LIL SIR dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch, gamely held the place. PURPLE SUTHERLAND was well placed early, rallied into the stretch along the rail and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. WANNABETHEBISCUIT was unhurried early, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. BRETT'S MAVERICK was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. POPULAR DUDE failed to menace. JOHN THE BANKER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. BIG PHONE BILL was no threat.
