### Footnotes

COAX ME KATINK saved ground to the stretch, came through inside rivals to challenge entering the lane, dueled to midstretch before drawing clear late under urging. BUDAPEST STAR tracked the pacesetters from the two path, angled wider approaching the stretch, finished willingly and held the place. MICHELS SISTER raced well off the pace to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch, had a late rally and narrowly missed second. ALOHA MAIDEN raced in midpack early, made a three wide bid approaching the stretch, dueled outside of the winner to midstretch before weakening. ARABIAN GEM pressed the pace from the two path around the turn, tired through the stretch. PUBLIC ENEMY was outrun. REGAL'S BIG GIRL came through inside rivals to take the lead on the backstretch and went clear a half mile out, got pressure to her outside on the turn, faltered through the stretch.
