SENATOR GOLDSTEIN dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FAR EAST was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. OPEN ALLIANCE was no factor but did improve position. DARK HOUSE failed to menace. SUPER CHILD was no threat.
