BOUNTY HUNTER stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied on the turn and drew clear in upper stretch, was all out to hold sway late. NOAH'S HUMOR was unhurried early, rallied on the turn and loomed boldly, flattened out and ran evenly late, was vanned off after the race. SHAREHOLDER DUES was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too little too late. SATUM (CHI) was unhurried early, had a late rally and was gaining late. DOOMER flashed brief speed, faltered and faded. YOUR IN FOR HALF set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back.
