### Footnotes

MY DADDY'S JEWEL set the pace early with a long lead, while on the inside into the turn and held late in the final stages. HABERDASHERY was squeezed at the start then chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch run. PRINCESS KUMA angled off the rail into the turn with some gain in the stretch. AREQUIPA swung into the six path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch drive. MY TWO ROSES was through after a half. I KICKD DA SHERIFF was never involved. BRENDA'S WAMPUM was done early.
