DANZIG'S GRANDSON dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew clear on the turn, dueled gamely through the stretch and was all out to hold sway late. POWER IN THE SKY was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. AMAZING RACER stalked the pace from the outside early, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. PURE STIMULUS dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered in the stretch and ran evenly late. GLIT OUT A BAGHDAD was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. FIX IT BILL was well placed on the outside, had no rally. MIMI'S MIRAGE failed to menace. TOPHATCAT was no factor. FLEET MOVER was outrun and had no excuse.
