SMART REASON showed good speed from close to the rail, held well to deep stretch but could not hang on late while outfinished to the wire. SUN VALLEY STORM raced evenly and lacked the late response needed in the drive. IMISSWHAT'SISNAME was never a menace. SUGARFOOT dropped back quickly.
