SCHOOL LASS stalked the pace while saving ground and never far back, rallied on the turn and got through along the rail, drew off late under firm handling. STARTIN SOMETHING dueled for the lead and set the pace, could not go with and was no match for the winner, gamely held the place. HOLLERAN was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. JUJU BLING was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. SO SO SMART showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. THE PERFECT LEADER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. DEB'S GIRLY GIRL was off slowly and was never a factor. THROWS IT DOWN flashed brief speed before stopping and fading.
