KADEYA stalked the pacesetters from the rail on the turn, angled out in midstretch and rallied under urging to take the lead leaving the sixteenth marker, prevailed under steady handling. REAL SWISS TRICK raced within striking range while outside of the winner to the stretch, finished willingly for the place. DINNER ROSE raced just off the pace on the backstretch, moved up to challenge in the two path on the turn, dueled to midstretch before weakening late. WESTBOUNDTRAIN saved ground racing well off the pace to the stretch before putting in a mild rally. SOUTHERN WINDSONG raced well back to the stretch and also had a mild rally. LOUIE'S LOVER sprinted clear early, was challenged on the turn, fought on willingly to midstretch but tired late. STORMY PATIENCE showed little. SATIN SAGE was never a factor while racing inside. LUCYOSO raced in midpack on the backstretch, was between horses on the turn, dropped back through the lane. EVERLASTING GLORY raced four wide while retreating quickly on the turn.
