ENDLESS SPIRIT settled on the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn while close up, rallied to the front approaching midstretch and quickly drew clear under urging. STRICTLY HIGH BROW dueled inside of SAN ANTONIO ROSE early, shook that one off and went clear approaching the turn, was headed by the winner approaching midstretch, proved no match but was easily second best. FOXY IDOL RED saved ground within striking range to the top of the stretch before weakening. LULU'S WAY was outrun while trailing the field early, swung out seven wide entering the stretch and passed tired ones. FLOVILLA raced close up along the rail on the backstretch, was in tight and forced to steady at the seven sixteenths pole. PASSANN was never a factor. MERELY MONEY raced in midpack throughout and showed little. PRINCESS HALL raced four wide on the turn while being outrun. DAT'L DO IT and LITTLECHILIPEPPER were both outrun. REGENCY ROAD raced four wide on the turn while in midpack, gave way. SAN ANTONIO ROSE vied for command outside of STRICTLY HIGH BROW early, slipped back approaching the turn and tired badly.
