UNDOCUMENTED stalked the pace from between horses early, was allowed to settle on the turn and was angled out, drew clear in the stretch and was all out to hold sway late. JUICY POINT was unhurried early while five and six wide and lost ground, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. FABLED WARRIOR pressed the pace and dueled for the lead from between horses early, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. HUM THAT TUNE was void of early speed on the outside in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. EL POLLO VOLANDO set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, faltered in the stretch and faded. OREE was no factor while wide and lost ground. DEVOTED GROOM failed to menace. P. P'S TO FOLLOW broke in the air and then was six and seven wide and lost ground, was no factor.
