Footnotes

JOHN THE BANKER set all of the pace while saving ground, drew off when challenged on the turn, was fully extended through the stretch to add to the margin. SILVER TALK RIB stalked the pace from the outside, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. DARE HE GOES was unhurried early, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. CHASE THE BLAZE was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, ran evenly with no rally. EAST ON STROOP failed to menace. S. R. LITTLE MAN broke in the air, was outrun.
