POLITE LIL SIR stalked the pacesetter to the stretch, made a bid from between rivals in upper stretch, drew clear under urging. PYRITE PERSONAL chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch, made a bid outside rivals in upper stretch, couldn't match the winner through the final furlong and proved second best. MATCHER was steadied leaving the gate, moved up into midpack while three wide on the turn, rallied to contention while lugging in a bit a furlong out, was straightened and finished evenly. NEIL AND JOHN raced in midpack from the two path to the stretch, moved closer in upper stretch, failed to produce a rally. NEVER FORGET broke a step slow, raced five wide while well back on the turn, passed tired foes. CRUISE LINER sprinted clear early, was headed by the winner in upper stretch and weakened. HEAD TO TOE was never a factor. HAVANNA AT NIGHT raced close up in midpack early before dropping back. NAVY COMMANDER chased the pacesetters from the rail to the stretch before tiring.
