Footnotes

A FLEETING MEMORY stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the far turn and drew clear, was fully extended to add to the margin late. FAST DEPOSIT was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, could not get to and was no match for the winner, was second best. I SHALL RETURN set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. MOROX was no factor and showed little. SILVER TALK RIB was in a good stalking position while four wide, ran evenly with no rally. JOHN THE BANKER bobbled at the start, was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the backstretch and led to the far turn, faltered and faded in the stretch.
