### Footnotes

DIAVOLETTO was pinched back at the start, was rushed up and dueled for the lead from the inside, drew clear in upper stretch and was under heavy pressure to hold the margin late. EYES SUPER FREAKY stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the after being angled out and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. LICENSE TO BLING dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside, faltered and faded. POTENTIAL ARGUMENT was unhurried early, rallied on the turn while five wide, hung and ran evenly late. MERCER'S MARK was well placed on the inside, ran evenly with no rally. NOT AN ALTAR BOY was no factor but did improve position. UNCLE VIRGIL showed good early speed chasing the pace on the outside, gave way and dropped back. RISKY ROMANCE failed to menace. BAKERS HAULOVER was checked repeatedly on the backstretch while in tight, had no rally. DOCTOR DIEGO was no threat.
