JUST MICHEL stalked the pace racing three wide to the stretch, loomed a threat outside rivals in midstretch but proved second best. ROYAL CUP pressed the pace inside of the winner to upper stretch before weakening slightly. FLIP SIDE was never a factor. NOBLE KITTY was outrun. DEVILISH CANDY chased from the rail on the turn, tired badly through the stretch.
