HOTNITESINMICHIGAN dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, drew clear on the turn and was under constant pressure to add to the margin late. DURAZNO dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, could not go with and was no match for the winner, gamely held the place. CHIEF EXECUTIONER was well placed early, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FOXY ON SUNDAY was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. MALIBU MYSTERY was taken back at the start, had no rally or excuse. TEST MARKET flashed brief speed, faltered and faded. VOSE THE HOST failed to menace. LEGIONARY was no threat.
