DINNER ROSE stalked the pace from the rail on the backstretch, moved to the two path and advanced to take the lead midway on the turn and quickly went clear, widened in upper stretch and prevailed under an aggressive hand ride. BOATMAN ROAD raced three wide in the second flight on the backstretch, chased the winner around the turn, couldn't keep pace in upper stretch but saved the distant place. OVERCAME raced between the top pair while in the second flight on the backstretch, remained within range to the stretch, failed to rally and was outfinished for the place. TRES FLARE set the pace from the rail on the backstretch, was overtaken mid turn and tired through the lane. CORKIE'S PRINCESS ducked in leaving the gate and was away slowly, saved ground to the stretch and was never a factor. HONEY'S MUSIC showed little. SUPER VALU trailed throughout while racing well off the rail and being outrun.
