STRONG AS STONE was away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside, drew clear in the stretch and was ridden out to maintain a safe advantage. RE LUHUK (ARG) allowed to settle, rallied in mid stretch, split horses and was up for second. NAPOLEON J dueled with the winner, could not match strides in the stretch but continued on willingly. ONE BAD DUDE never far back, put in a mild bid in the stretch. TOMMATOR allowed to settle, did not threaten. TINQUILCO (CHI) was never a factor. LARGO showed little and trailed.
