TRISKIN stalked the pace while five wide, closed determienly and wore down his rivals from the outside. CARIDADS' IMAGE pressed the pace, rallied in mid stretch and drew even, was outfinished late but was second best. BOLD MERCY dueled early, gained a clear lead on the turn, weakened slightly in mid stretch. MARCOS TRACKER pressed the pace while racing wide, lacked a late response. KATARMA well placed, lacked a late kick and went evenly. YEAR TO CATCH KAT slow early, found his best stride late. BILAN was never a threat. HIS AIM IS TRUE pressed the early pace, gave way in the stretch.
