JETTIN TWISTER was away alertly and set all of the pace while off the rail, had a large lead on the turn, was fully extended to hold the margin late. TAPITSDONTLIE was pinched back at the start, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. TIGHT JEANS was unhurried early, had a late rally and some late gain but too late. WE GAIJIN stalked the pace with good early speed while five wide, had a mild late rally and some late gain. FEISTY ME was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. CALL RICHIE failed to menace. KELSEY MISS was no threat. MARKET GENIUS showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. GREEDY DEBBY flashed brief speed before stopping.
