POPULAR MISS K was off slow while unhurried to the turn and moved up while no real threat. FANCIEST was well placed from inside to the turn but gave way in the drive. DEFENSIVE AWARD was no menace. IRENE THE BIG ONE never a threat. HIGH AWARD bore out on the backstretch, eased through the stretch and and walked off.
