HE'S OUTTHERE HIM duelled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, drew off in upper stretch and was fully extended to the wire. TEA DERBY drifted in soon after the start and forced RED ILLUSION into the gap, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. RED ILLUSION was forced into the gap, was unhurried early and ran evenly with no rally. MCGIRR N DODGE duelled for the lead and set the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
