RED LIGHT RUNNER sprinted to a clear lead at once, raced unchallenged to the stretch and held sway in the final furlong. SENORITA'S SECRETS was off a bit awkward, raced in good position to the stretch run and rallied while drifting out in the final sixteenth. BETTER SAFE tried to stay with winner to deep stretch but faded in the drive. IVORY TICKLE unhurried to the stretch and moved up late outside while no real threat. MARSELLA DELIGHT raced evenly and lacked a late response when needed. MORNING REWARD darted to the rail soon after the break and was never a threat. DARLING DISARRAY chased winner for a half but gave way readily in the stretch run.
