WILD BUSHROSE has no speed to the turn, came wide through the stretch and brushed with foe in deep stretch and drew clear in the final sixteenth. MUSKEGON stayed with the pace early, rallied outside into the stretch, brushed with the winner and gamely held place. LEMON PULP trailed to quarter pole angled out for run into the stretch and finished fast from outside. STAR OF ASPEN had no speed to the turn, split horses into the stretch and moved up. SOLID INTHE MIDDLE rushed to stay with leaders but faded in the drive. ATALANTIS showed good speed to set pace to deep stretch but faltered in the late going. DIGGIN FASTER well placed while never far back wide but could not keep up and faded in the drive. RETAIL saved ground to no avail. CATHOLICSSCHOOLGIRL bobbled at the start and also saved ground to no avail and dropped back after a half. FRENCH GORGAS was through early while racing extremely wide.
