Footnotes

SCIOTO BOOTSKI stalked ROLLIN ME OUT to the stretch, took the lead entering the lane, went clear a furlong out and held sway late under urging. J. R.'S TOWN raced in midpack on the backstretch, moved closer while four wide on the turn, finished willingly and was gaining late despite failing to switch leads through the lane. TRUTH MATTERS was bumped leaving the gate, raced along the rail in midpack to mid turn, finished with interest. SLIGO CREEK raced well off the pace to the stretch before putting in a late rally. WAIST GUNNER JOHN raced well off the pace to the stretch, finished evenly along the rail. KNIGHT VILLAIN was forced in and had to steady in a chain reaction shortly after the start, trailed to the stretch before putting in a mild rally. ROLLIN ME OUT sprinted clear while setting a fast early pace, was overtaken by the winner entering the stretch and tired. JOHN Q'S WINNER came in leaving the gate and early, forcing rivals inward, raced just off the pace from the rail early, angled out three wide approaching the turn, was in tight while trying to rally leaving midstretch and lost momentum. BAD HOMBRE chased the pace from the rail to mid turn, faltered.
