LEAD THE PARADE dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside throughout, could not get by the winner in late stretch but was clearly second best. G MANS GAL stalked the pace on the outside throughout, was wide and had no rally. PRISSY LINDA was well placed on the inside while up close early, ran evenly through the stretch and had no closing response. MARY'S WILD FLOWER was no factor while wide and showed little. R NURSE C failed to menace while saving ground throughout.
