BETTER BE NOW set the pace outside of ROSS N' BENS GIRL on the backstretch, went clear on the turn, widened through the final furlong under an aggressive hand ride. PYRITE FOREST raced four wide while advancing to contention on the turn, finished evenly for the place. BUY YOU A BEAR chased the winner to the final furlong but weakened late. CHRISTY DE LIT raced well off the pace to the stretch, passed a couple of tired rivals through the lane and just missed third. ROSS N' BENS GIRL raced close up along the rail to midway on the turn before tiring. BLUSHING CALLER broke outward, raced in midpack on the backstretch before giving way. WATER RUN DEEP raced four wide on the turn while being outrun. LAYED BACK CHARLIE was outrun.
