Footnotes

CRYPTOVILLE was unhurried racing well back to the final turn, angled out six wide entering the stretch, rallied strongly through the final furlong and got up at the wire under urging. LILLIANS CHOICE stalked the pacesetters early, came through inside rivals to challenge midway up the backstretch, dueled on the final turn, inched clear in upper stretch, continued willingly but was caught in the final strides. TOMMEYESGOLD stalked the pace early, made a bid outside rivals on the backstretch, dueled outside of the winner on the final turn, lugged in a bit in upper stretch, was straightened and went willingly to the wire despite failing to switch leads through the drive. MERCY saved ground tracking the pace to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch, went willingly to the wire while finishing between rivals. LUVAPRIVATE raced four wide on both turns while in midpack to the stretch, had a mild rally without reaching contention. LADY ZORA chased the pace racing three wide to the final turn before weakening. BASHERIT sprinted clear early, was challenged from both sides on the backstretch and began to tire on the final turn. JONMARIE'S GOLD showed little. CRUCIAL POINT was never a factor. SYBLES ANGEL flashed brief early speed before retreating on the backstretch. IRISH VISION bore out entering the first turn and was forced to check, showed little thereafter. Due to a timer malfunction no splits were available for this race.
