MORE D'AMOUR dueled while three wide on the backstretch and outside of ROSE COLORED LADY on the turn, kicked away in upper stretch and widened to the wire under urging. COED RUTH E. was steadied shortly after the start, finished willingly for the place while never a threat to the winner. I'LL BE PRAISED raced in midpack while three wide on the turn and finished evenly for third money. MS. QUIMET angled out entering the turn, raced four wide on the bend and had a mild late rally. ROSE COLORED LADY dueled from between horses on the backstretch and along the rail on the turn, weakened through the stretch. ETHY was outrun. SPANISH SASS vied along the rail on the backstretch, slipped back entering the turn and faltered. P R STAR was outrun.
