SPEED MONSTER stalked the pace with good early speed while off the rail, drew clear in upper stretch and was fully extended to the wire. CRIMSON CLAY was well placed while five wide and lost ground, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FAST DEPOSIT was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. MCFRENCH showed good early speed chasing the pace, ran evenly with no rally. GREATBELLS OF FIRE set the pace with good early speed, faltered in the stretch and faded. SUNSHINE BOI was no factor, had no rally or excuse.
