GOOD AND FAST dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, dueled gamely throughout and was all out to prevail in a long drive. TSUNAMI WARNING stalked the pace while four wide, rallied into the stretch and dueled, could not get by late and was outfinished to the wire. NAPOLEON J set the pace with good early speed to the first call, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. HOLD THE CHARGE showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. CHECKSANDBALANCES was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. IQUITAROD was no factor. BATCHES IS TYLER flashed brief speed while five wide and lost ground, gave way and dropped back. DISCOVER JETS flashed brief speed before stopping.
