SPECTACULR SPARKLE stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the outside, rallied into the stretch, drew off under constant urging. KATIE'S LADY was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. DEE'S DANCING was in a good stalking position while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. SAHIYA dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. STORMY SUNRISE was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. NAPOTE dueled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and dropped back. LIVE TODAY failed to menace. RUPERTACTOFDUTY was no threat. POKEY CAT was no factor. WHYWHY ME flashed brief before stopping.
