**Footnotes**

BERNT TO RUN was unhurried early while five wide, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leaders, drew clear late under constant handling. MISS BOCEPHUS dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, drew clear in upper stretch, weakened and dropped back. RESULTA dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. OPEN BANK was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. NOTREADYTOBENICE showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back. LITTLE FRUIT FLY was in a good stalking position while five wide, had no rally. STERLING EMBLEM was no factor. DELAWARE DEBUTANTE failed to menace. I'D BE FIRST flashed brief speed before stopping. STONE RUNNER was no threat.
