CONFUSED GENIUS stalked PLAYFUL SQUAW to the second turn, took command and went clear early on the bend, was headed by the runner up in the final sixteenth, continued willingly and gamely held sway. EVIL TRICKS raced along the rail in midpack to the second turn, moved closer on the bend, rallied to challenge a hundred yards out but could not push by. GRAB THE LADY raced well off the early pace, saved ground moving closer on the second turn, had a mild rally. BET WHOM trailed for the first half mile and passed only tired rivals. BOONE TOWN LADY hopped leaving the gate and was away slowly, saved ground to the stretch, angled out but failed to rally. SWEET MIRACLE raced four wide on the second turn and was never a factor. PLAYFUL SQUAW set the pace from the rail, was overtaken by the winner entering the second turn and tired. BLUSHING CALLER chased the pace racing three wide but was finished after a half mile and dropped out.
