SHOCK N STORM stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the turn and drew off in upper stretch, was ridden out to the wire. CHASE THE BLAZE was in a good stalking position, rallied into the stretch, could not get to the winner but was second best. NO LAC O ZIP set the pace while saving ground, faltered in the stretch and faded. RAMBLIN MIKE was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. BURKY'S PRIDE was well placed in mid pack, had no rally. DARE HE GOES failed to menace. WAHRAN was off slowly, was no threat.
