KING SNOOP was away alertly and set all of the pace while off the rail, drew off in the stretch under constant urging. MALIBU HARBOR stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, was no match for the winner but was clearly second best. PERFECT ATTENDANCE was in a good stalking position while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. ISWEAR ISWEAR was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. WANDERING MANN was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. CHARLIE'S ACADEMY showed good early speed, faltered and faded. QUICK CARNAGE failed to menace. PLAY THE MARKET bobbled at the start, and bore in, was no threat. JORDAN RAY clipped heels soon after the start when foe came in, was no factor. K. BOY was no threat. FINAL QUEST was no factor.
