JUNEBUG ONASTRING was in a good stalking position while never far back, rallied on the outside and dueled, drew off under heavy pressure. LAN LAN dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch but was second best. AREQUIPA bobbled at the start, dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered in the stretch and began to fade. DONTFLATERYOURSELF was unhurried early in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. FANTASTIC MADAME showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back. SAUDI SERENADE failed to menace.
