NATALMA'S LIGHT was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the far turn while six wide, drifted out at the quarter pole and then drew off in upper stretch. RACING DEE was void of early speed, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. MILEHIGH LOVE was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat to the top two. BELL'S BELLES stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. THEPRICEWASRIGHT pressed the pace early, rallied on the backstretch, failed to sustain the bid and faded. IT'S HER TURN was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. ARGO NAVIS failed to menace. PEEKABOO KNOCKOUT set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded.
