STEPHEN'S QUEST was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied on the far turn and had a large lead in upper stretch, was all out to last late. JUICY POINT was unhurried early, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. FASON was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat to the top two. CITIZEN JOHN pressed the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. OLDHAMBURG duelled for the lead and set the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back. TIO CHENCHO flashed brief speed before stopping. BOSTON OUTLAW set the pace with good early speed, weakened and faded. SQUANDER failed to menace. TARA BULL was no threat and was eased on the turn.
