

ONE TRUE BUDDHA was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, rallied on the turn and dueled, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. HARRY CANARY was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. PYRAMIDIC failed to menace. SAHM'SL'ILSOLDIER was no factor. DOC MILL stumbled at the start, was no threat.
